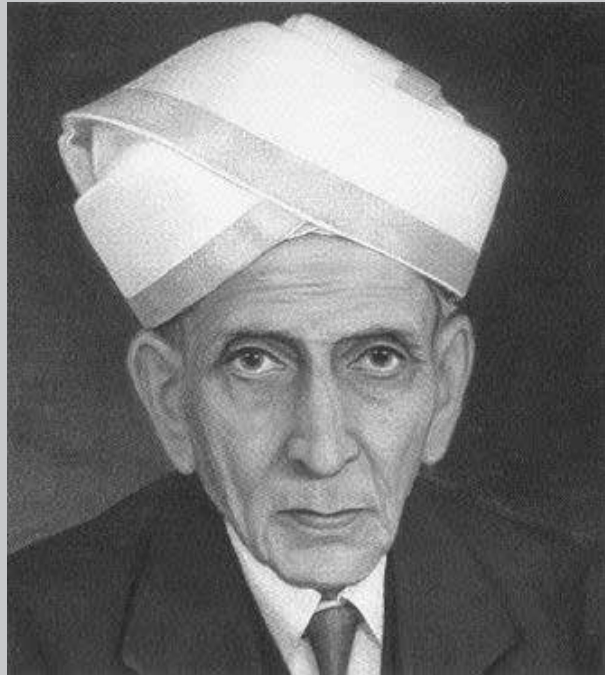

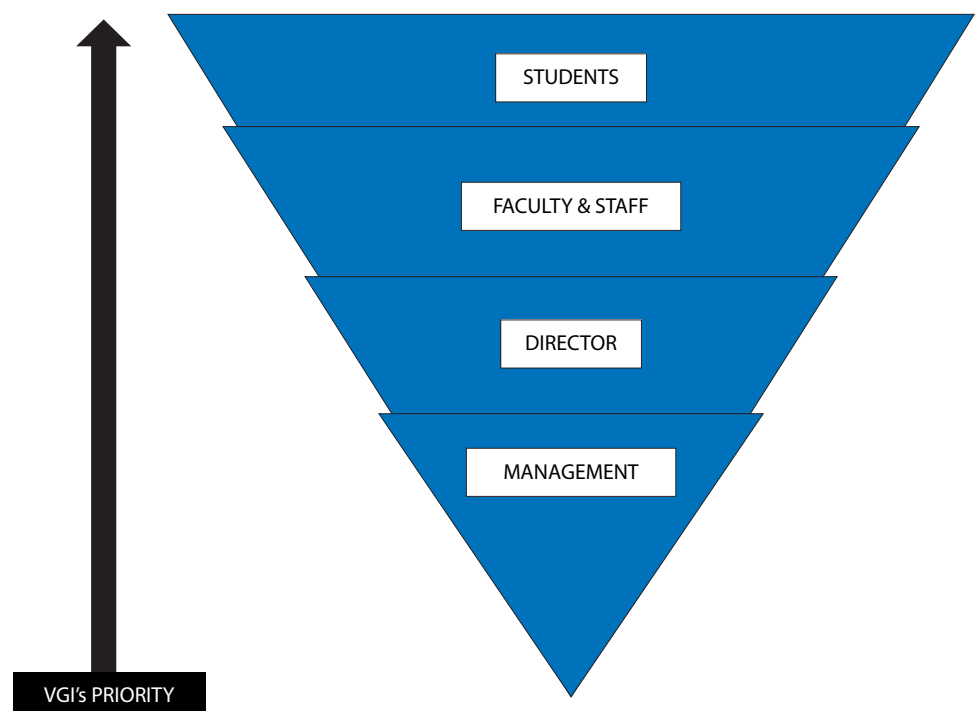

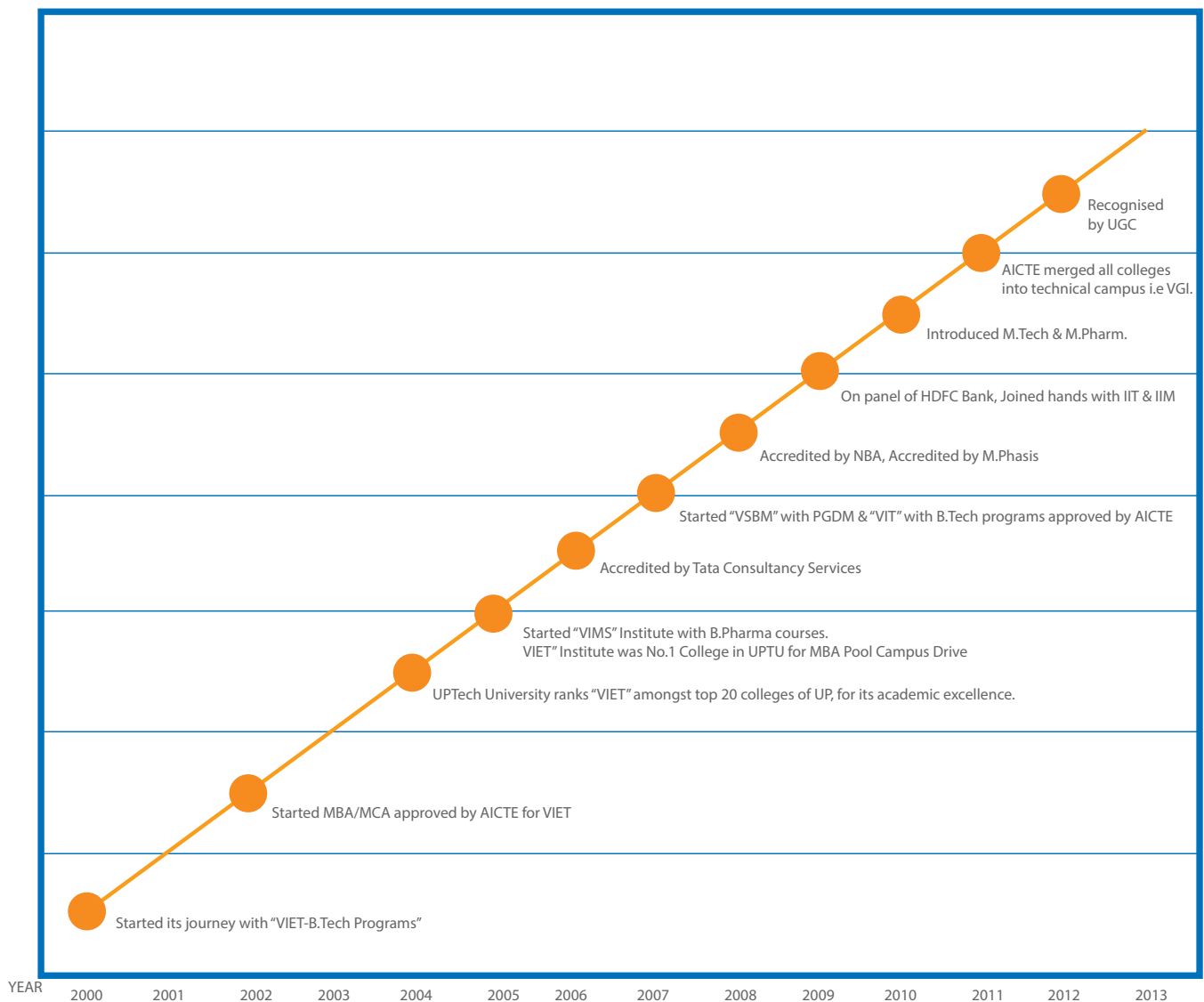

Applied Science & Humanities

The Department of Applied Sciences, with a fraternity of 50 faculty members, is one of the strongest assets of VGI. The faculty members are equipped with adequate knowledge, wisdom, strength and stamina to motivate students.



Computer Science & Engineering

Accredited by NBA in 2008, the department is well equipped in Computer Graphics, Database Computer Networks, Computer Organization, Artificial Intelligence, Distributed Computing, Computer Architecture, Operating System, Digital Image Processing, Software Project Management Lab etc. This department is skillfully managed by qualified and experienced faculty members. Through our highly updated teaching methodology, we inculcate knowledge, wisdom in the students for their overall development.

We have excellence in multitude of computer discipline like computer architecture, databases, networks, real time, distributed systems, etc. Our USP is a technical community, GROUND ZERO FORUM FOR COMPUTER APPLICATION (GOFCA), a mission that was formed to bridge the gap between the college and industrial expectation, thereby giving the student members an idea of the real arena of Computer Science.



Electronics & Communication Engineering

The department of Electronics & Communication Engineering was Established in July, 2000 and M. Tech in the year of 2011. The department has a separate building with adequate rooms for theory and laboratory classes. Latest Technologies, such as audio visual facilities are used in classrooms. In addition to teaching and research work, faculty members have presented papers in various national and international seminars.

The department also arranges training courses and workshops during summer and winter vacations to cover subjects like VHDL-Verilog, Robotics etc.

Civil Engineering

The Department's intention is to be in the forefront of advanced research in Civil Engineering and very pro-active in industrial interaction and technology development. There are seven well equipped laboratories attached to different divisions for conducting teaching, research and consultancy activities in areas of Fluid Mech., Building Material, Building Planning & Drawing, Structural Analysis, Geoinformatics, Hydraulics & Machine, and Surveying.

The department aims at providing the students of Civil Engineering with a strong, broad-based, education which can help them in developing the basic intellectual and organization skills that allow them to meet the present Industrial demands with up to-date technological, social and environmental knowhow. NIRMAAN, a technical community consisting of students, faculty and staff offers many activities, including guest speakers, annual competitions of Bridge Making Event, Technical Quiz, Group Discussions, Motivational Talks, Personal Interviews and social activities to enhance the engineering education experience of students and to transform them into better Engineering professionals of high ethics.



Mechanical Engineering



The department was established in 2001 and has an intake 180 students. An M.Tech is also available for those look for a PG degree.

The Department of Mechanical Engineering is blend of theoretical and practical experience with state-of-the-art workshops, laboratories and qualified faculty members.

A 5,000 sq ft well-equipped workshop houses latest equipment – welding, sheet metal working, carpentry, fitting and smithy shops.

Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Electrical Engg.

The department was established in 2003 and offers B.Tech and M.Tech courses. The department continuously interacts with industries like hydro, nuclear, thermal power plants, transmission & distribution substations and smart grid control system manufacturers to keep itself updated with the latest technology and trends.

Every year, B.Tech students are sent for 4-6 weeks practical training in thermal and hydro-electric generation plants, 400 kV substation and HVDC transmission and control system in NTPC, NHPC, PGCIL, BHEL and WIPRO.

Moreover, application of electronics and computers in electrical engineering, like smart grid control from 400kV Ballabgarh (Haryana) substation and expert system for online fault detection of latest electricity generating equipment are being used with latest developed maintenance techniques to keep students abreast with industry practices.

EATO, a technical community of students of Electrical & Electronics department, is a forum where students share technical & innovative thoughts with each other to upgrade their knowledge.

Information Technology

The Department of Information Technology offers B.Tech courses accredited by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

Under the watchful eye of concerned and competent faculty, students are imparted with the right combination of theoretical and practical training. Well-equipped laboratories, furnished as per AICTE standards, have been made available to the students. Around 240 state-of-the-art computers with internet facilities are available round-the-clock.



Department of Pharmacy

Vishveshwarya Group of Institutions started the Pharmacy College in 2005 to impart high quality education in the field of pharmacy. VIMS conducts B.Pharma & M.Pharma courses approved by AICTE & **Pharmacy Council of India (PCI)** and affiliated to UPTU, Lucknow **(PCI)**. The students have access to well equipped labs for practical knowledge. The labs are equipped with state-of-the-art instruments like: FT infrared spectrophotometer, Jaysco HPLC Shimadzu(1600), U.V. Flame photometer, Digital M.P. Apparatus & visible spectrophotometer, as per norms of PCI.

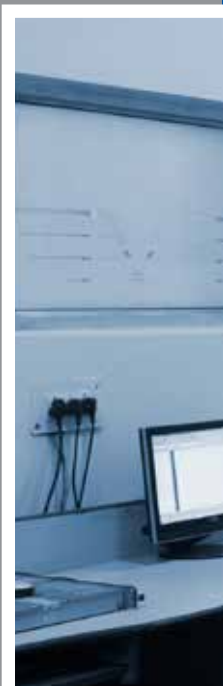
Master of Computer Application

MCA, affiliated to UPTU is a full-time, six-semester programme spread over three years. The first five semesters are a blend of intense classroom learning and hands-on experience through computer laboratories, project work, industry exposure, workshops and seminars. The sixth semester consists of industrial training, where students are required to work on a real life project for 6 months with an industrial/commercial organization.

This programme provides necessary theoretical background and practical exposure in computer science and applications to meet the growing manpower requirements of the Global Software Industry. After completion of MCA, students are ready for excellent job opportunities in global IT brands, as well in Research & Development at prestigious institutions in India and abroad.

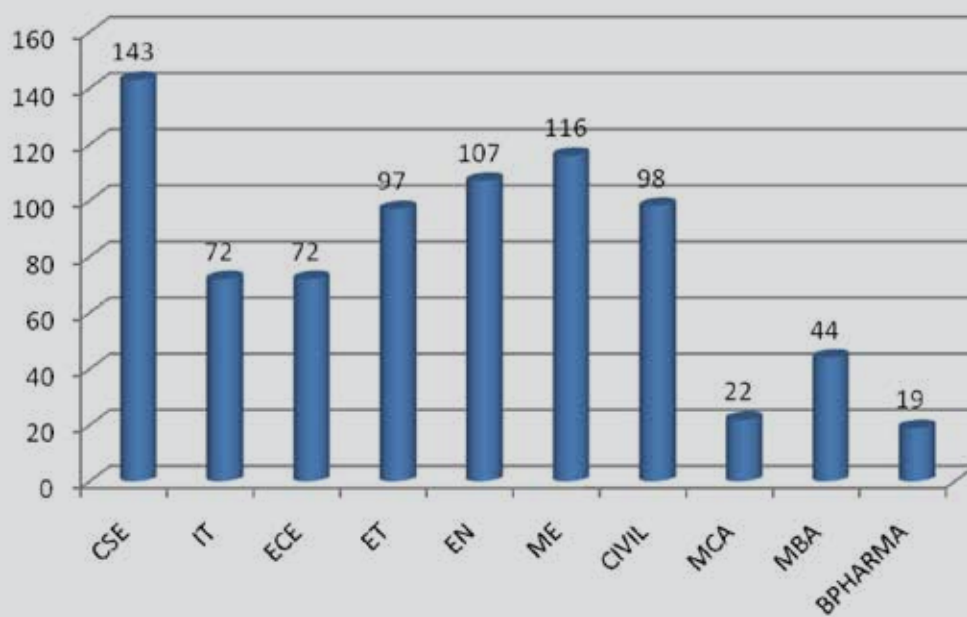

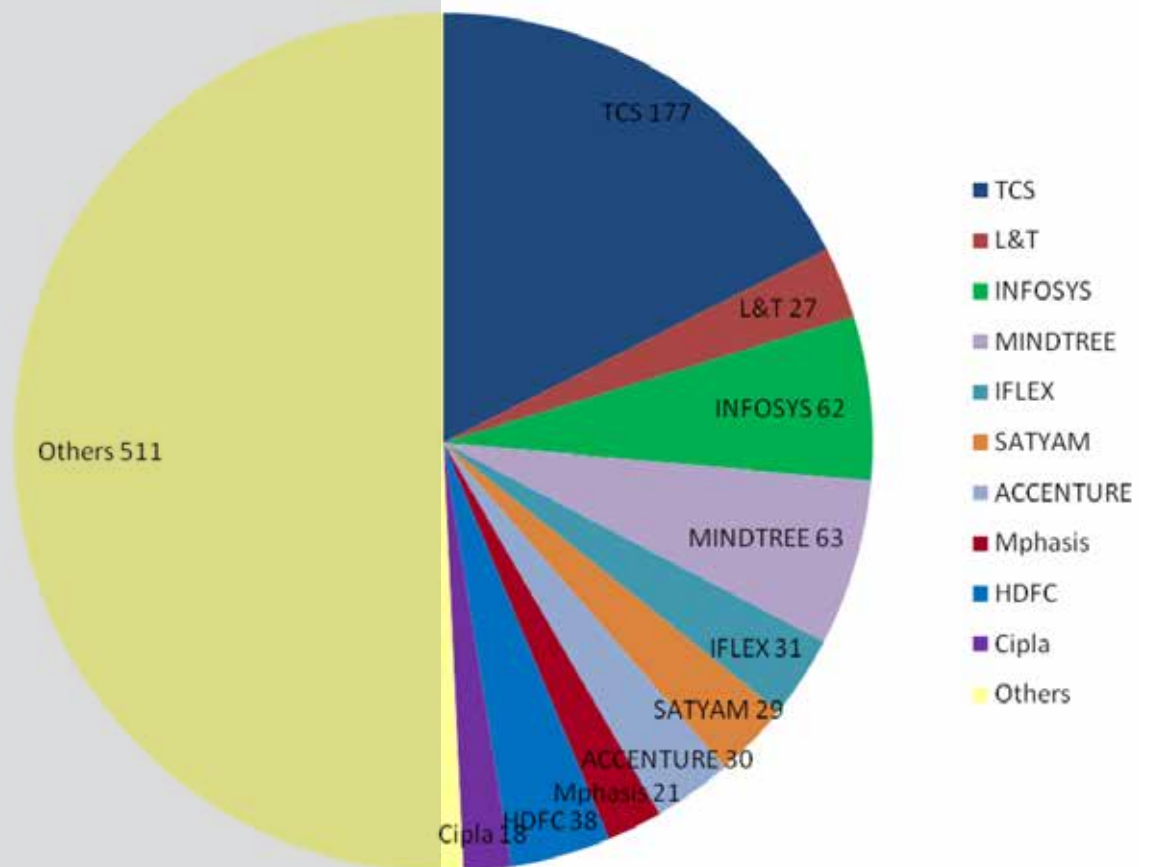
Placement Status (Last 3 Years)

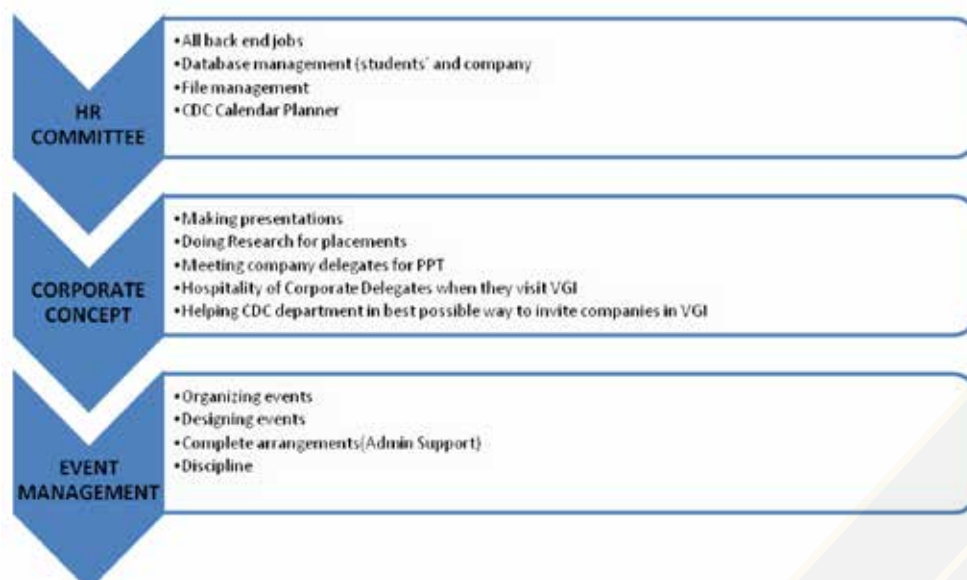

Retail Food Outlets and Cafeteria

The cafeteria, located within the Institute's premises, caters to the needs of the students with hygienic and quality food at reasonable prices. The nicely designed cafeteria, managed by the institute, serves delicious food, meals and snacks throughout the day to students and faculty at subsidized rates. Apart from this, students enjoy home-cooked food at the in-campus messes, along with Nestle retail outlets.

Medical Care

VGI provides adequate medical aid to the students and staff at its medical care center/ dispensary, under a full-time Medical Officer. We also provide ambulance service for the students and staff.



We have three independent libraries – Central, Pharmacy & Applied Science. Each library has a collection of electronic and hard copy formats and provides learning, teaching and research support services to students, as well as staff members. VGI central library is spread over 1,000 sq. m, with a sitting capacity of over 400 students in the reading and reference sections. It has more than 4,500 titles and over 33,000 books on various subjects. It subscribes to more than 150 national, international, e-journals and magazines.



Library

The automatic issuance and returning of the books is supported with the latest software. All computer systems in the campus are networked and can access the electronic catalogue of the library. Electronic display and photocopy facility is also available to the students. Institutional membership of DELNET (Developing Library Network) and BCL (British Council of Library) enable users to gain access to thousands of other member libraries. An electronic library has been set up to access data base electronically.



Hostel



VGI provides the best hostel facilities in campus separately for boys and girls. The well-furnished hostel rooms provide a comfortable stay for students. Hostels have facilities like hot and cold water supply, medical aid, electricity backup, security, Internet access and recreational facilities. The hostlers coming from different states are also grouped together to develop a culture of sharing and cooperation. To provide an environment conducive to academic and personal development, all residents are required to follow a code of conduct. At present, VGI has sufficient infrastructure to accommodate 1,100 boys and 350 girls in an academic year.

Other Facilities

Students and staff can avail campus facilities, such as, STD/ISD/PCO service, medical dispensary, bank, ATM, post office, shopping center, playground, gymnasium, hobby clubs, and meditation hall, etc. There is also a guest house complex for visitors/parents. VGI is affiliated to Uttar Pradesh Technical University, Lucknow, and is approved by AICTE, New Delhi, UGC and PCI.

For admissions in VGI, the rules and regulations are followed as per guidelines and instructions of the University and AICTE issued from time to time. Further, 15% management quota is allowed by the University for Direct admission.

The admissions on management quota are also held as per the rules and guidelines of the University and AICTE issued from time to time.

Admission Procedure for Counselling Students

1. The candidate can report to the institute only up to the date given in his/her UPSEE counseling letter during institute working hours
2. If he/she is allotted a seat in another institute through UPSEE, he/she will lose his/her allotted seat
3. Once a candidate applies for withdrawal of his/her admission, he/she automatically forfeits his/her claim for the allotted seat
4. Registration charges, academic fee, hostel fee and transport charges once paid are not refundable
5. SC/ST candidate (whose annual income is less than Rs 2 lakh and is a domicile of UP) desiring relaxation in fees will have to fulfill all the relative formalities at the time of admission
6. In case a candidate desires to avail bank loan facility, he/she will submit a copy of UPSEE allotment letter. The institute authorities will then issue him/her loan letter for educational loan. To obtain loan, however, is the sole responsibility of the student
7. All candidates, who get allotment through counseling, will submit academic fee, examination fee, caution money, transport and hostel fees at the time of admission
8. Hostel accommodation will be provided on first-come-first-serve basis

Admission Procedure For Management Quota

1. Candidates desiring to take admission through management quota will follow UPTU guidelines
2. For any enquiry, they may directly contact institute
3. Admission to all undergraduate and postgraduate programmes will be on the basis of performance in the PI and as per their marks in PCM/ PCB/ UPSEE/JEE
4. Admissions to all courses offered by Vishveshwarya Group of Institutions is steered by the admission committee consisting of experienced faculty members, professors and counselors
5. The allotment of the branch to the student shall be at the sole discretion of the institute authorities. The branch will be given to the candidate as per the availability of seat in that branch
6. The Admission Committee is responsible for conducting entrance test, declaration of results and merit list, counseling and final admission to the courses
7. Once a candidate applies for withdrawal of admission, he/she automatically forfeits his/her claim for his/her allotted seat
8. In case, a candidate withdraws before starting of the course, the wait listed candidate will be given admission
9. Registration charges, academic fee, examination fee, hostel fee and transport charges once paid, are not refundable in case admission withdrawal is done after start of the session
10. Hostel accommodation will be provided on first-come-first-serve basis
11. In case a candidate withdraws his/her admission in between the session, no fee whatsoever will be refunded to the candidate. Furthermore, balance dues, if any, will be recoverable from the student

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO FOREIGN NATIONALS (FN) / PERSONS OF INDIAN ORIGIN (PIO) / CHILDREN OF INDIAN WORKERS IN GULF COUNTRIES (CIWGC)

FN/PIO/CIWGC seats shall be filled from Foreign Nationals / PIOs/CIWGC who:

- Have passed the qualifying examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics, which is considered equivalent to (10+2) examination by the Association of Indian Universities.
- Possess valid SAT-II score with Mathematics level II C, Physics and Chemistry.
- Should submit a copy of passport or equivalent evidence in support of their nationality.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR FN/PIO/CIWGC CANDIDATES

- For all undergraduate and postgraduate programs offered by VGI, candidates must qualify with Common Admission Test-VGI, English Proficiency Test followed by a personal Interview round (provided the candidate fulfills the minimum eligibility criteria for the programme / course opted). The Admission Committee is responsible for conducting of the entrance test, declaration of results and merit list, counseling and final admission to the courses.
- Provisional admission letter can be issued to enable the Indian Embassy to provide a student visa (only student visas are acceptable) to the concerned International Student.
- After getting the student visa, the applicant is required to pay the fees. This fees may be paid in USD or the equivalent sum in Indian rupees.

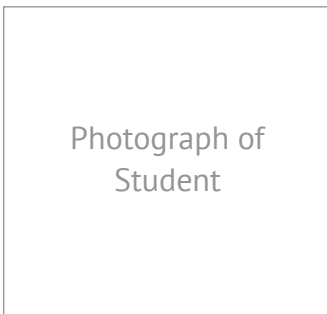

DISCIPLINE

Attendance:

1. Attendance is compulsory in Lecture/Lab/Tutorial & wellness and official College functions. According to University norms, a minimum average attendance of 75% is required for appearing in End Semester Examination. A student having shortage of attendance shall not be allowed to appear in the End Semester Examination.
2. Be punctual for all lessons and official College functions.
3. Absence from Lecture/Lab/Tutorial or official College functions must be accompanied by a medical leave or prior leave approval granted by teaching staff concerned.
4. Leaving the College during teaching hours can only be granted with an official leave form signed by the concerned HOD or Director, VGI.
5. A student who has been detained due to shortage of attendance shall not be allowed to appear in University/Sessional examination of the semester. The University Enrolment number of such student shall however remain unchanged and he or she shall be required to complete the programme in a maximum permissible period of academic years as per UPTU norms.

Conduct:

1. All students are to maintain good conduct and behavior during their stay in the Institute
2. All students are required to carry ID cards while in Campus. Identity Cards, when demanded, should be shown to the competent authority
3. Students are required to go through all the notices on the Notice boards every day.
4. Follow all instructions given by the teaching staff. Students should consult their Class Coordinator, Head of department, or Faculty members if they have problem or are in doubt
5. Take pride in and carry out conscientiously all work and assignments
6. Consume all food and drinks within the cafeteria only. Return all utensils to the respective receptacles provided. Food wrappers, disposable cups and plates should be thrown into the dustbins
7. Observe all safety rules
8. Mobile phone must be switched to the silent mode or off while in the Institute
9. Students are required to notify the College of any change in their addresses or personal particulars

College Property:

1. Students are to refrain from moving any property belonging to the College unless authorized.

Anti-Ragging Measures: Submission Of Affidavit By The Students / Parent / Guardian

BAN ON RAGGING

Ragging is strictly banned in Vishveshwaraya Group of Institutions. The definition of ragging is reproduced below:

“Any act causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his person or exposes him to? Ridicule or forebears from doing any lawful act, by intimidating, wrongfully restraining, wrongfully Confining, or injuring him by using criminal force towards him or by holding out to him any threat of Such intimidation, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force.”

Further some of the acts that would be construed as Ragging are listed below:

(a) Compelling a student to address the seniors as ‘Sir’ or ‘Madam’ (b) To perform mass drill. (c) To copy class notes for seniors. (d) To serve various errands. (e) To do menial jobs for the seniors. (f) To ask/answer vulgar questions, (g) To look at pornographic material ‘to shock the freshers out of their innocence’. (h) To force to drink alcohol or scalding tea etc. (j) To force to do acts that can lead to physical injury/mental torture or death. (l) To do other obscenities. (m) To force the students to do any act which amounts to ridicule or degradation of human dignity. (o) To use physical force/assault of any nature. (p) Abusing.

The above list is by no means exhaustive. Any act that the authorities consider falling within the ambit of Ragging given in the definition above would invite severe punishment. Any student found indulging in Ragging would be expelled from the College/University. In addition, an FIR would also be lodged against the defaulters. Students are further advised to desist from indulging in Ragging. Defaulters would be dealt with severely.
